



Art Camps - Summer 2010

Art camps will be held at Fremont Community School in the Art studio, on the front porch and in the fenced front yard. All camps run Monday through Friday, 9:00am-1:00pm and cost \$195 except Comics and Sewing which is a two week camp and costs \$375. If a child registers for 3+ camps, the price is \$180/camp (\$360 for Comics and Sewing.) Payment is due with registration. FCS provides snack, but the children bring a lunch from home. *FCS is a peanut free school.*
